Phonics - revise	All initial sounds Phonicsplay Flash Cards phase 2 & 3 Tricky Word Trucks
Teach:	'sp' Please see the 'sp' poster below and explain how it might sound like sb but words don't start with these two letters together.
Reading:	Blending for reading: If you write the following words out can your child have a go at reading them? spot, spin, spoon, speck, spark Challenge - put sp words into sentences for your child to read. Make some alien words i.e. sparf, spooss, spaig, spoan ...
Writing:	Sentence/s containing the sp blend and if possible the word are. I.e. There are spots on the spider. I am in space! Are you going to spin? Another activity could be if you use the 'sp' words i.e. spot and write it out then cut it into individual letters so s-p-o-t muddle them up - you say the word then can your child put them in the correct order? Be careful if you have a digraph! Maybe they could tell you if there is a digraph hiding in the word before it is cut up!! They could then copy these words.

If you do not have paint at home your child could use any objects that you have several of. It could be stone, stick, stone, stick or car, lego brick, car, lego brick... To extend this further you can try repeating patterns using 3 or 4 objects i.e. car, lego, pencil, shoe, car, lego, pencil shoe ...
