

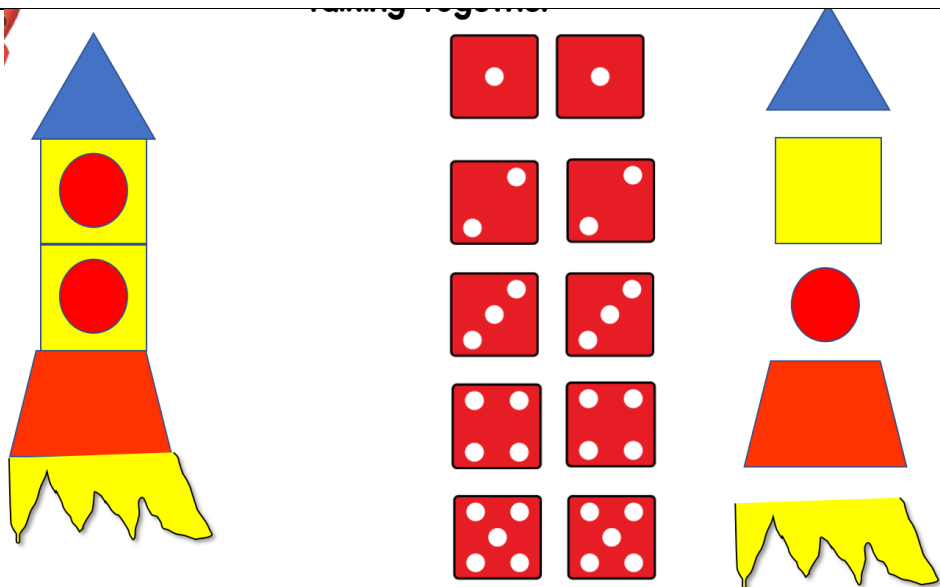

Hi Reception children,

It's Thursday!

On this plan you will find today's virtual Maths, Phonics and Handwriting. In Maths you are playing a doubling game, in Phonics you are learning the "ae" split digraph and for handwriting you are practising how to write capital letters!

<p>Maths</p> <p>Mental Maths- 10 mins</p> <p>Maths 20 mins</p>	<p>Today we are going to be doing some doubling!</p> <p>Let's start by singing... "Dancing Doubles".</p> <p>CTRL and click on the picture to take you to the song.</p>  <p><b>Rocket Doubles Game</b> Solve the double problems to make your rocket and get all the parts ready to set off!</p>  <p>You will need a dice.</p> <p>If you don't have one use this generator link:</p> <p><a href="https://www.online-stopwatch.com/chance-games/roll-a-dice/">https://www.online-stopwatch.com/chance-games/roll-a-dice/</a></p> <p>You will need 2 dice.</p> <p>Roll the dice. See your double number.</p> <p>Look at which part of the rocket you can draw. The winner is the first person to draw a complete rocket.</p> <p>You will need to roll a six to start. (On either of your dice.)</p>
