Then we will add groups together!



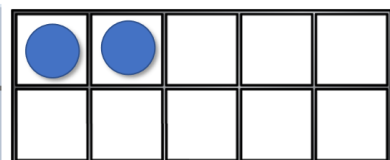
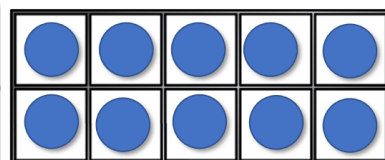

One more goat comes along. How many legs now?

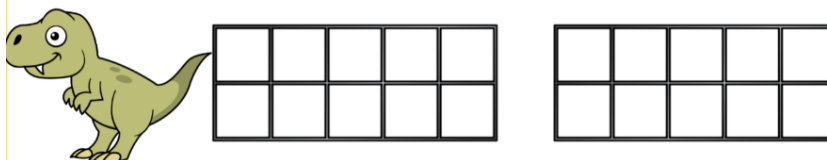


Here we have three dinosaurs.

How many legs?



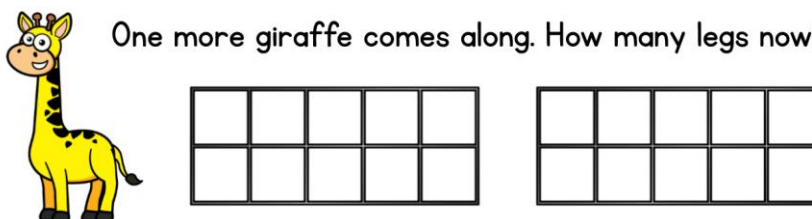
One more dinosaur comes along. How many legs now?

Here we have two bees. How many legs?

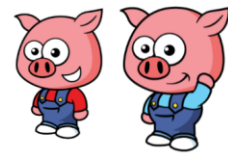
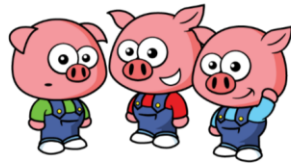


One more bee buzzes along. How many legs now?

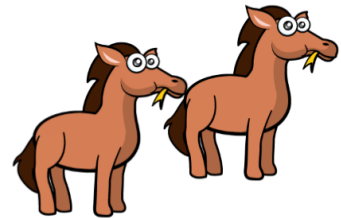
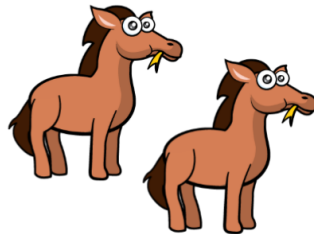


Now have a go at adding 2 groups-
