

Read some of these questions to a partner taking it in turns and then try to answer them:


- 1) Is the Yeti hot?

Watch and listen to this song called 'Who has more?'





#MathsEveryoneCan

Gather together a collection of up to 5 objects.
Hide some of them in a bag or box, leaving the rest of your objects on the floor where you can see them.




How many objects can you see?
How many of your objects must be hidden in the bag?






#MathsEveryoneCan

Collect a set of objects and count how many you have altogether.
Give a friend some of the objects and hide the rest in a bucket or box.
Can your friend work out how many objects you have hidden?



Change the number of objects and the number hidden each time.
Then take it in turns to work out how many are hidden.

Weather Mobile Project


Task:


